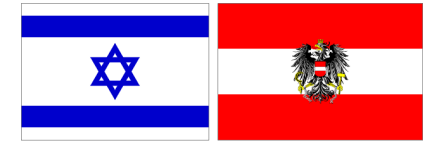
2. Diversity Studies
