<b>Field</b>	Erasmus+ Youth
<b>Call year</b>	2026

<b>Total budget available for allocation</b>	At least 3.336.946,80 EUR
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The budget is apportioned to applicable allocation criteria in the following way:

<b>Minimum grants</b>	At least 1.300.000,00 EUR (~40 % of total budget)
<b>Qualitative performance and policy priorities and thematic areas</b>	At least 2.002.168,08 EUR (~60% of total budget)

<b>Exceptional costs and Inclusion Support for Individuals</b>	100.108,40 EUR (~3% of total budget)
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<b>Minimum grant</b>	Each applicant will receive a minimum amount of: 50.000,00 EUR
	Method: The aim is to ensure that each organisation holding an accreditation can organize at least one small to medium sized mobility project.
<b>Maximum grant</b>	An applicant can receive a maximum grant of: 250.000,00 EUR
	Method: Based on accreditation plans submitted and the number of accredited organisations.

<b>Penalty Clause</b>	Applicants that have used less than <b>80%</b> of the awarded funds in their last completed accredited project (KA151) will have their minimum grant amount reduced by <b>20%</b> .
	Applicants that have completed their last accredited project (KA151) with an absorption rate below <b>80%</b> will receive at most the grant amount that they were able to absorb.
