Some project ideas:			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> We try to improve the combinatorical way of thinking in such a way that we created a teaching material for students of 5th and 6th year which consisted of 8 lessons based on each other. During the research we examined the successfulness and effectiveness of the teaching material. In the research topic of mathematical concept forming in nursery school we constructed a plan by the help of which we wanted to determine the level of logical abilities of children of nursery school age. During the measuring the mathematical competence of our students we examine the mathematical knowledge of the first and the third year students by a detailed test and we examine the successfulness of our work by comparing the results of the test. In the research topic of analyzing digital curriculum we examined the applicability of Geomatech in mathematical teaching at primary school. Social factors of mental health and wellbeing in EC are investigated. Main focuses are social support, friendships and parental mental vulnerability, which is a chronic distress factor causing developmental difficulties in EC. However supportive resilience factors are also important therefore we investigate these resilience factors with qualitative and quantitative methods. Planning and implementing research with children especially in the early childhood needs specific research methodologies that consider the developmental characteristics of children. The workshop gives the opportunity to the participating students to get to know research methodologies that belong to research with children, e.g. observation, techniques 			



based on children's play, story completion and a special method, the PAIR (Pictorial Assessment of Interpersonal Relationship) technique (Bombi, 2007). The workshop also encourages students to find out and test new research methods and techniques.

7. Education carries the disadvantages deriving from the disparities and inequalities from the very beginning, and not only amplifies the existing ones but creates new ones at every turn. A smooth transition from kindergarten to school depends on the helping, supporting educational methods and cooperation of the family, the kindergarten and the school. The complex analysis of the kindergarten transition into school is aimed to approach the issue with many criteria and there required different methods and methodological solutions in different part of the research.
8. Sexuality in early childhood is even nowadays misunderstood and prejudiced field if interest in education. However positive sex education can play an important role in healthy sexual development in childhood. Our aims are to investigate parents' and teachers' beliefs and views about sexual development, to reveal effects of early sexual experiences and direct education – as roles of adults' beliefs and behaviours in development of healthy sexuality and gender concepts.
9. One of the most important issues in education is how to improve the effectiveness of classroom-level processes, increase the quality of teaching and develop teachers' practical knowledge. The aim of the Higher Education research group is to analyse problems in the field of higher education, support strategic planning, and evaluate development programs and actions in higher education. Almost all curriculum development interventions aim at a process that has implications on individual, institutional and national levels improving teacher learning, as this is the most important tool in supporting teachers to cope with new challenges.
10. The teachers' and teacher candidates' implicit and professional beliefs, their motivation and ideas for their careers play an important role in their professional development. The research can focus on career motivation of entering teacher candidates, exploring their previous experiences, examination beliefs using qualitative and quantitative methodological approaches. Further research goal is to study the effect of the teacher training on motivation, role interpretation, attitudes and knowledge of specific areas.
11. Investigating and exploring the ways in which East Asian education is promoted in international surveys. The form of archaic teaching and its present forms and their fields of application and possibilities. With special regard to Martial Arts.
12. The Health-conscious education research lab was founded with the idea to improve the efficiency of health development in the Infant and Early Childhood Education, in Pre- School and Primary School Teacher Training. The aim of the research is to discover the factors that can influence the health-conscious comportment in children and they have a major role in developing a sustainable lifestyle.
13. Researching plastic skills development in early childhood (kindergarten/preschool age, 3-7 years). The development of plastic art skills from the ages of 3 to 7 in light of the CEFR_VL competency model. Diagnostic tests of the three-dimensional artwork (3D) within the system of visual education.
14. Sustainability education in early childhood. Our main goals: to establish a successful cooperation among the universities in the Carpathian Basin region to make the sustainability education more effective. With partner university carry out a questionnaire for measure the students knowledge, skills, habits, attitudes and willingness in the field of "Sustainable lifestyle and environment"; to develop student's way of thinking, educate responsible citizens with positive values and attitude towards the main global and local challenge of sustainability; the development of future teachers competences in the field of sustainability to be able to form children's attitude. We would like to provide for them methods, instruments for a better and effective education and teaching in future generation.
15. The professionals considered differently that the quality of the hospital education is a critical factor which depends on the adequate funding, the practical application of the educational research, the quality guarantees and the continuous, ongoing training of teachers. In the research there is a systematic and multi-faceted analysis of the history of the hospital education in Hungary. In the comparative analysis we highlighted the practice of those countries where the hospital education is considered special.
