



OeAD | Erasmus+ Cooperation and Study Trip South Caucasus (Azerbaijan, Georgia, Armenia)

The National Agency Erasmus+ Education (OeAD-GmbH) organises a one-week cooperation and study trip together with the Erasmus+ Offices in Azerbaijan, Georgia and Armenia to the three countries of the South Caucasus region of Azerbaijan, Georgia and Armenia. The purpose of this trip is to establish and strengthen contacts between higher education institutions in the countries involved. This trip focuses in particular on

- increasing knowledge of the higher education systems of these countries;
- Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (KA107) with opportunities for students (study visits, internships) and for teaching and further education mobility,
- initiating contacts in the field of capacity building in higher education, and
- possible further forms of cooperation.

Within the framework of this trip the higher education systems and study programmes as well as examples of good practice from these countries will be presented. Moreover, there will be ample opportunities to get to know the higher education institutions and to plan cooperation in concrete terms. Information materials from Austrian higher education institutions may be sent collectively to the event locations in advance. The OeAD lecturers working in Baku and Yerevan will take part in the programme.

The target group of the cooperation trip are employees of Austrian higher education institutions who are interested in establishing partnerships and who have been vested by their institutions with the authority to initiate cooperation. There is no restriction with regard to subject areas or study levels; together with the local partners we will seek to 'match' the areas of interest.

Seminar content and course of events

Date: May 12th - 17th/18th, 2019

The trip has been planned in such a way that it is possible to visit all three countries. Alternatively you may visit just two or one of the countries. For the exact course of the study trip please see the attached programme (additions and the final programme will be available at the beginning of 2019).

Costs: A fee of 800 Euros per participant will be charged for participation in the entire study trip. This includes participation in all events, accommodation on site, the meals specified in the programme and all transfers between the venues. Any costs in excess of this amount will be borne by the National Agency Erasmus+ Education.

Participation in the subsequent excursion in Armenia (one-day, May 18th) is optional for a fee of 50 Euros – see programme on page 5.

Participants will have to organise flights and possible visas (Austrian citizens only need a visa for Azerbaijan, official passports are exempted from the visa requirement) themselves, the costs are not included in the mentioned amount. Erasmus+ OS funds may be used to cover the costs.
