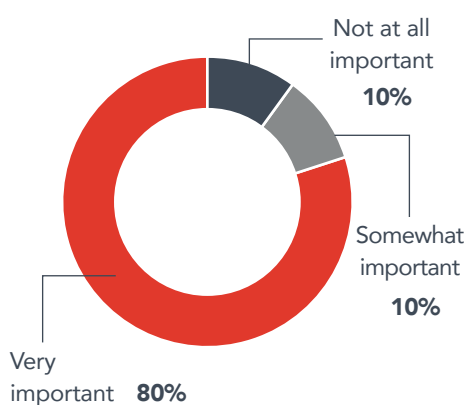


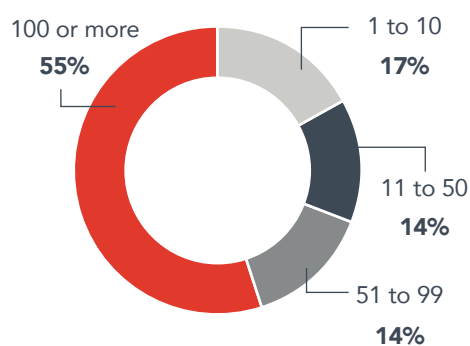
Top 5 Reasons for Developing International Partnerships
