The history of Lesya Ukrainka Volyn National University (VNU) began in 1940. Currently, the University offers Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD degree programs, which are taught in Ukrainian and English, and it holds the fourth (the highest) level of accreditation from the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine. At present, the University academic community consists of 750 employees, among them 95 are doctors of sciences/professors and 600 are at the Ph.D./'candidate of sciences' level. The University offers postgraduate courses in which post-graduate students can obtain doctoral degrees in 24 academic branches. Five specialized research committees deal with the defense of doctoral theses in seven research fields. The Faculty of Foreign Philology started its work in 1962 as the English Language Faculty of Lesya Ukrainka Lutsk State Pedagogical Institute. In 1979 it was reorganized into the Faculty of Foreign Languages, and in 1992 - into the Faculty of Romance and Germanic Philology, based on which in 2012 the Faculty of Foreign Philology was established				
established. The Department of German Philology was founded in 1993. The opening of the specialty 'Language and Literature (German)' at Lesya Ukrainka Volyn State University at the Faculty of Romance and Germanic Philology was not accidental. Life itself dictated it, because our region is located near the western border. In recent years, there has been a significant increase in interest in learning foreign languages, contacts with Germany have grown significantly, and there is an urgent need for specialists who speak German. The opening of such a specialty was preceded by the establishment of the Department of German Philology in September 1993. The department, among its four other educational programs, prepares bachelor's degree students under the educational and professional program "Secondary Education. German and English Languages. Foreign Literature". International mobility provides an opportunity to delve into the subject area together with a study group and partners, with a focus on the latest scientific achievements and the intertwining of theory and practice. In certain courses, participants will be able to explore topics from both theoretical and practical perspectives, apply the

The project "Innovators of the Future: Laboratory of Sustainable Development of Territories" is aimed at stimulating the economic development of territories through education, innovation and scientific research. The main goal of the project is to promote the development of local communities, increasing the level of economic literacy and supporting innovative initiatives among young people. As ZPSU is experienced in Project proposals preparation and successful project coordination and management, we have enough experience in the academic field. However, our priorities for the next 10 years are focused not only on academic field development, but also on scientific research promotion. We trust that Ukrainian researchers could make considerable contribution not only to Ukrainian economy and overall development, but also to approach to the EU level and work together with EU researchers and communities

As a result of mining activities in the world, at least 15-20 million hectares of land have been disturbed, of which 59% is used for various mining operations, 38% - for waste heaps or cleaning rejects, 3% - subsidence, sinkholes and other surface disturbances associated with mining. The volume of waste heaps and industrial waste is more than 2000 cubic km. On average, 0.1 hectares of land is allocated for waste heaps for every 1000 tons of raw materials, and they occupy hundreds of millions of hectares, often more fertile land. This problem is vital not only for Ukraine, but also for the EU. Moreover, Ukraine and other countries under martial law face a huge problem on construction waste management (products of the destruction of residential areas and cities after massive missile attacks). There is an urgent need to study how this waste could be recycled in economically and ecologically effective way. The Mining Industry is poised to experience a digital revolution that promises enhanced efficiency, safety, and management. Ukraine conforming the digital and green transformation is also ready to join comprehensive research to better adopt digital tools, incl. IoT, at quarries and processing plants. We have experience in drones' application at open- pit quarries, VR introduction in study process, etc.

In such a way we are open to discuss ideas both to launch mobility projects for students and staff, develop CBHE and Cooperation Partnerships projects in the field of Mining and Environmental Protection, and start joint research activities within the mentioned academic fields and beyond with researchers and departments of Mining, Mineral Recourses Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Construction, etc.
